# **Congress Participation and Publication Conditions**

## **Extended Abstract Submission and Evaluation**

- Congress applications will be made through the participation form below.
- The articles or research submitted to congress should not have been presented or published elsewhere.
- The congress is open to the participation of academicians, doctoral candidates and researchers with forensic sciences experts from Turkiye and abroad. The language of the congress is Turkish and English and simultaneous translation will be provided.
- Extended abstract; It should be prepared in the desired format and sent as an attached file to "ukongre@jsga.edu.tr" or "adben@jsga.edu.tr" addresses until December 30, 2022 in the "\*.doc" or "\*.docx" format.
- Extended abstracts are available in Turkish or English between 400-750 words; It should be
  prepared to include abstract, introduction, research method, methodology, and conclusion
  sections.
- The abstract section of the papers in Turkish will be in both Turkish and English.
- Extended abstracts will be evaluated with the application of "blind refereeing" by taking into account criteria such as compliance with congress topics and scientific conditions and originality of the articles and research.

# **Publishing of the Extended Abstract Booklet**

• The booklet containing the abstracts of the accepted papers will be prepared in electronic format (\*.pdf) and published on the Congress webpage.

## **Submission of Full Paper Manuscripts**

- Full text submission is not mandatory, it is subject to the preference of the authors.
- According to request of the authors; the full paper manuscripts presented at the congress and accepted after being evaluated in line with the "blind refereeing" system will be published in the JSGA Security Sciences Journal Congress Special Issue (in the first half of 2023) or as a book chapter in an international scientific book to be prepared (in the second half of 2023). Authors should also indicate which publication option they prefer when submitting their full paper manuscripts.
- Papers that are not presented by the authors during the congress will not be evaluated for the full text.
- The full paper manuscripts prepared by the authors should be sent to the "\*.doc" or "\*.docx" addresses as an attached file in the format of ukongre@jsga.edu.tr or adben@jsga.edu.tr until April 30, 2023 in accordance with the publication rules of the Journal of Security Sciences of the Gendarmerie and Coast Guard Academy.

## **Sending a Poster Presentation**

Poster presentations in accordance with the main theme of the Congress will be accepted by the Organizing Committee following the evaluation. The following points will be taken into consideration in the evaluation of the poster presentation:

- The posters submitted to the congress should not have been presented or published elsewhere.
- The posters can be prepared in Turkish and English.
- The posters should be in  $70 \times 100$  cm size.
- Times New Roman should be used as 24 points as a font.
- 2 cm margins should be left from the left, right, bottom and top edges of the paper.
- In the upper left corner of the poster is the name of the Congress, the logo of GCGA; In the upper right corner, the name and logo of the institution/organization/university of the poster presenter should be placed.
- Headings should be at least 2 points larger than the font size used in the text and should be written in bold.
- The names, surnames and addresses of all authors should be specified and the name of the participant who will present the poster should be underlined. The e-mail address of the corresponding author should be given and it should be written in Times New Roman, 24 points.
- References in the text, figures, tables and bibliography should be prepared by adopting the APA-6 style.
